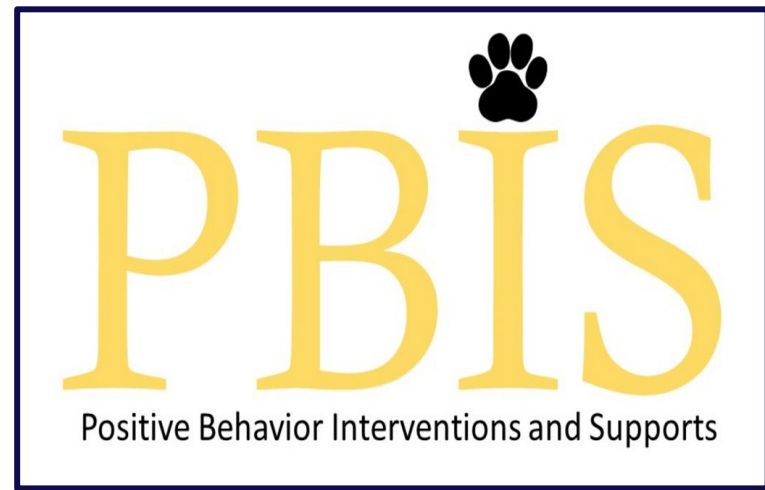
# First Two Weeks of School
